Staff News

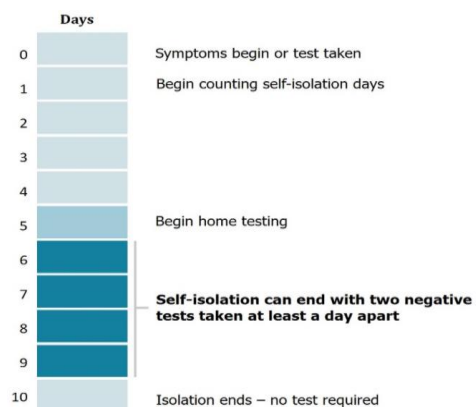

Covid Procedures

There have been lots of changes in covid procedures over the past few weeks and these are likely to change in the future. At the moment, children who test positive on a lateral flow test should self-isolate and you should contact school to let us know - these children do not need to have a PCR test. We will then communicate to parents/ carers that there has been a positive case in the class. If your child has one of the recognised symptoms of covid, they should get a PCR test. The information on the Gov.uk website states:

'Anyone who has one of the core symptoms of COVID-19 – a high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – should self-isolate and take a PCR test. They must self-isolate if they get a positive test result, even if they have had a recent negative lateral flow test – these rules have not changed.'



Your child can test on day 5 and day 6 of their isolation and if these tests are both negative then they can return to school. If the day 5 result is still positive then they should test daily until they have two negative test results 24 hours apart. If your child is testing positive on day 10 they can still return to school on day 11 as they have reached the end of their isolation period.

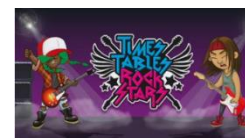
Parent Consultations – Reception, Y1, Y2, Y3, Y4, Y5, Y6
