Nursery

In Nursery this half term, the children have enjoyed learning all about the life cycle of a butterfly. The Nursery received five little caterpillars, which we watched grow each day until they made their cocoons. We can't wait to see them turn to butterflies after the half term. We have listened to lots of stories about minibeasts and plants. One of our favourites was 'The Very Busy Spider' where we learned lots of facts about spiders and loved looking for webs in the Nursery garden. We have enjoyed playing in our role play in the classroom which has been a garden centre and a shop this half term! To end of the term we learnt all about the story of

Easter and its meaning to Christians. We made Easter cards, cornflake cakes and even had an egg hunt!

What a great way to end the term.

In phonics, we have been really tuning into sounds and hearing the first sound in lots of words, including our name. We have started to orally blend with 3 sounds and we have moved on to blending words with 4 sounds e.g. nest, tent. We are all working very hard with our segmenting and blending and becoming so confident with this!

In maths, we have been learning all about the number 5. We can rote count to 5 forwards and backwards and are beginning to do this from any starting number e.g. 3,

4, 5. We have started to think about other numbers that we can use to make 5 like 4 and 1, and have used Number blocks to help us with this. We have started to learn about measurement including tall, long and short.



Reception

In Reception this half term we have been learning all about animals and their babies. The children have matched adult animals to their young and created some wonderful spring themed animal art work. We have been looking for signs of spring and noticing how the seasons changing has been shown in the school ground on a Spring walk.

In phonics the children have now looked at the sounds from phase 2 and phase 3 and are beginning to write in captions and sentences. We are encouraging the children to write independently in preparation for year 1.

Ducklings

The highlight for Reception in Spring 2, was welcoming some new visitors to our classroom in the form of fluffy ducklings. We were lucky enough to watch them hatch in an incubator from an egg. The children then decided what we were going to name them. From the ducklings, we completed lots of different activities. We counted them, discussed the different colours they were, completed some amazing sentences about them and drew them during our art lessons. Before they left us to venture to their new home, the children got to hold them and see them learn to swim. It was an amazing experience for our Reception children and we loved creating this memory with them.



Attendance
