The children have been working extremely hard and have thoroughly enjoyed the build up to this festive time of year! Year 1 - Mathematics

The children have experienced a highly positive half term and have made progress in many curriculum areas. The pupils have developed their knowledge in the mathematical area of money; they have learnt to recognise coins and notes of different denominations and have developed the ability to calculate using coins. The children have also developed their understanding of capacity. It would be highly advantageous if you could support your child with this understanding in the home setting.



Year 1 - Religious Education

The children have further developed their understanding of the Christmas story and have explored why Christians celebrate Christmas. The pupils have investigated the meaning of giving gifts at Christmas time. The children have developed their artistic flair and have created their own gifts consisting of baubles and Christmas cards. The children are looking forward to giving their gifts to someone special for Christmas.



Year 2 – Science

The children have learnt that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited. They have been able to describe how different habitats provide the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other. The children have been able to identify and name a variety of plants and animals in local habitats, including microhabitats. Bill Oddie is the significant person that the children have explored and learnt about during this topic. The children have discovered that he is an avid bird watcher and likes to protect habitats for birds. The pupils made their own binoculars and went out into the school grounds to see which birds they could spot and identify. The children also created their own habitats; they thought carefully about which animals and plants would live there.
