Year 3: A Royal Tea Party

This half term, Year 3 have been learning about famous monarchs in Britain since 1066 and their impact on our lives today. The children have developed their chronological knowledge and have been using both primary and secondary sources of evidence to gather information on the British monarchs. They celebrated coming to the end of the topic with a British themed day and tea party. The children wrote letters to Her Majesty the Queen, informing her all about our exciting lessons over the past half term. The children finished this special day with a Great British Monarchs quiz, where they showcased their knowledge and worked collaboratively to see which team could earn the most points on their way to victory!



Year 4: Electricity

In their Science topic this half term, Year 4 have been learning about electricity. We have found out how electricity is made and how it travels to the different electrical appliances we use in our homes. Alongside this, we have identified and discussed the dangers around the use of electricity. The children have especially enjoyed our investigative work on electrical circuits – they were able to design their own circuit and use wires, bulbs, switches and batteries, to put together their circuit. The children tested them to make sure they worked as well as experimenting with them to see the effect a complete circuit and an incomplete circuit had on a bulb.



Year 5: Team Games – Cricket

This half term, Year 5 have been learning all about cricket. The children have developed numerous skills such as fielding, bowling and batting. In particular, our batting and fielding skills have shown some tremendous progress! We developed these skills over a range of weeks, before we were ready to put them into action over a series of matches (including Kwik Cricket). We all loved playing these games and we saw some amazing skills on show – some people scored a huge amount of runs after managing to clear the fence when batting! After this unit, we have also really enjoyed our athletics training (running, throwing and jumping) and we have loved our first lesson of rounders – we can't wait to learn how to play this sport after the break!



Year 6: Net & Wall Skills

This half term, Year 6 have been fortunate to have a Professional Sports Coach come into school to provide weekly training sessions on Net & Wall Skills. We were introduced to racket control, which included how to hold the racket correctly. We practised our underarm throws as well as tracking the flight of the ball in order to catch it successfully. We were then introduced to forehand and backhand shots and practised using the correct arm movements as well as attempting to play a rally applying both shots. We learned how to track the flight of the ball and how to adopt a good starting position and as we became more confident, played rallies where we would score points. We thoroughly enjoyed this training!
