Attendance Reminder

Being in school every day and on time makes a huge difference to a child's progress and attainment, as well as their personal and social development. We understand that sometimes children are ill and cannot attend school and on those days it is vital that you contact school to let us know, preferably before 9:30am. We have a duty of care to know where your child is, so if they are not in and we don't hear from you then we have to start ringing home and on occasions we may visit the home to check in with children and families. It would be a great help if all parents/ carers could get in touch with school instead. Recently we have had quite a few children arriving to school after the gate closes.
